



Junior Student Code of Conduct for Online Lessons

Please always:

- arrive at your lesson one or two minutes before it starts, with your equipment ready.
- be in a suitable room in your home – not your bedroom, with a responsible adult available.
- mute your microphone when you are listening.
- turn your camera on for the lesson.
- use the Chat function to ask and answer questions about the lesson only.
- use your real name on Zoom. If not, you may be refused entry to the class.
- be respectful and polite to your teacher and classmates at all times. If not, the teacher may ask you to leave the class and your parent will be contacted.
- wear appropriate clothing for lessons (eg: not pyjamas). If not, the teacher may ask you to leave the class and your parent will be contacted.
- enter your class alone. Friends or relatives must not accompany you.
- only share your screen if the teacher asks you to share your work.
- contact your agent or group leader if you are unable to attend a class.
- do not share photos, your last name, address or other personal information during the lesson.
